Today pick up at your hotel and depart to Bologna, the capital of the prosperous region of Italy Emilia Romagna.

Not yet contaminated by mass tourism, the city is the ideal choice for cultural interludes as well as leisure activities and relaxation.

Bologna has a number of nicknames: la dotta (the learned) for the ancient university, la rossa (the red) for the warm color of the roofs and houses, and la grassa (the fat) for the wonderful food. At arrival, walk through the historical city centre, visiting Piazza Maggiore, Palazzo Accursio, Palazzo del Podesta', the Sala Borsa, the Fountain of Neptune, Palazzo Re Enzo, the Basilica of San Petronio, the Archiginnasio and the Anatomy Theatre.

Then, transfer to FICO Eataly World, the largest food park in the world. Enjoy a journey through its fields, factories, restaurants and kiosks, markets, and shops.

The tour starts from the fields: 20,000 sqm of outdoor areas to learn more about the main Italian crops and the most representative local animal breeds. Then, the Biodiversity Ambassadors will take you to the heart of FICO Eataly World: the 40 farming factories, where you can meet and speak with artisans to learn about the process of making iconic Italian food products. Hungry enough? It's time to stop by the world's largest Italian culinary offer! Over 45 restaurants, trattorias, bistros, and street-food kiosks to taste Italy's most traditional and innovative recipes. Finally, take a walk through FICO's 9,000 sqm area dedicated to markets and shops and, why not... take a little piece of Italy home with you!
